PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 1 (1 HOUR)

Elements Covered

1. Utilizing tools, equipment and materials for construction and finishing operations
2. Assemble shoe upper and bottom components

Tasks

- Assemble the shoe upper and bottom components.
- Shoe construction setup-tools and equipment layout.
 - Assemble the required tools and equipment for shoe lasting
 - Assemble shoe upper, bottom components
 - Observe safety of equipments and workplace according to organization standards operating procedures.

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 2 (6 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Carry out conditioning and shoe lasting operations

Task

- Carry out conditioning and shoe lasting operations
 - Condition the toe puff and the stiffeners
 - Lasting tools and equipments are set and adjusted accordingly
 - Flat/cement Lasting operations are carried out.

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 3 (4 HOURS) AND ORAL ASSESSMENT (1 HOUR)

Elements covered

1. Preform sole attaching operations
2. Carry out basic finishing operations

TASK

- Complete sole attaching operations and carry out finishing
- Sole attaching and finishing operations
 - Sole attaching tools and equipments are set
 - Sole attaching operations are carried out

- Carryout finishing operations

The assessor will proceed to ask you oral questions for 1 hour.

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
