PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 1 (4 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Cut footwear materials

Tasks

- Using the work ticket provided, you are required to cut footwear components for a basic shoe design using different materials.
- Work Ticket details
 - Shoe style: Basic oxford shoe
 - Size: Size 6-8
 - Quantity: 1 pair
 - Materials: upper leather, Canvas
 - Patterns: Size 6-8

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 2 (4 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Perform component marking and preparation

Tasks

- Carry out position marking, size marking and stitch marking
- Carry out splitting and perform folding skive.

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 3 (4 HOURS) AND ORAL ASSESSMENT (1 HOUR)

Elements Covered

1. Identify footwear materials
2. Perform component marking and preparation

Tasks

- Carry out edge staining along the raw edge of Oxford shoe components
- Carry out Gimping and perforation decoration of oxford shoe components.

The assessor will proceed to ask you oral questions for 1 hour.

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
