PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE:

1. This unit of competence shall be assessed in three phases.
2. Each assessment session has the duration included in brackets
3. The third phase of the assessment shall include a practical session and an oral assessment session.
4. The assessor will take photos and videos as you perform the tasks at critical points during the assessment.
5. Ensure all required resources for the assessment have been provided before beginning the assessment.

1. PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 1 (4 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Utilizing tools, equipment and materials for construction and finishing operations
2. Assemble shoe upper and bottom components

1.1 Tasks

- **Tool preparation:**
 - Set up workspace according to safety standards
 - Identify and select appropriate tools for footwear construction
- **Component Assembling**
 - Assemble shoe uppers, bottom components and the last
 - Fit toe puffs and stiffeners

2. PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 2 (4 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Carry out conditioning and shoe lasting operations

2.1 Tasks

- **Conditioning Operations:**
 - Identify appropriate conditioning method for upper material
 - Steam the shoe upper
- **Lasting Operations:**
 - Carryout lasting operation using cemented construction method.

3. PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 3 (4 HOURS) AND ORAL ASSESSMENT (1 HOUR)

Elements Covered

1. Perform sole attaching operations
2. Carry out basic finishing operations

3.1 Tasks

- **Sole Attachment:**
 - Prepare bottom surfaces through roughening and scouring
 - Apply polyurethane (PU) adhesive
 - Attach the lasted shoe to the outsole

- **Finishing Operations**

- Remove shoes from lasts
- Perform edge finishing
- Apply edge staining
- Carryout top-dressing operations
- Carryout inspection and packaging

The assessor will proceed to ask you oral questions for 1 hour.

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
