6. For the practical session, you'll be provided with a **sketch** and you have to **draft a freehand basic gents' garment patterns**.

1. PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT SESSION 1: CONSTRUCT A GENTS' SHIRT (6 HOURS)

Elements Covered:

1. Lay and cut garment pieces
2. Construct a gents' Shirt

Tasks

- i. Used Personal protective equipment
- ii. Gather required tools, equipment and supplies
- iii. Check functionality of the sewing machine before operating it
- iv. Develop the patterns for the gent's shirt
- v. Using the patterns drafted, lay, cut and transfer pattern marks for the gents' shirt pieces.
- vi. Stitch the garment pieces as per illustrated garment design and standard operating procedures and note the following;
 - Use plain closed seams at the side seams.
 - Double stitch the back yoke
 - Machine stitch the hem
- vii. Finish and package the shirt in the A4 envelope provided.

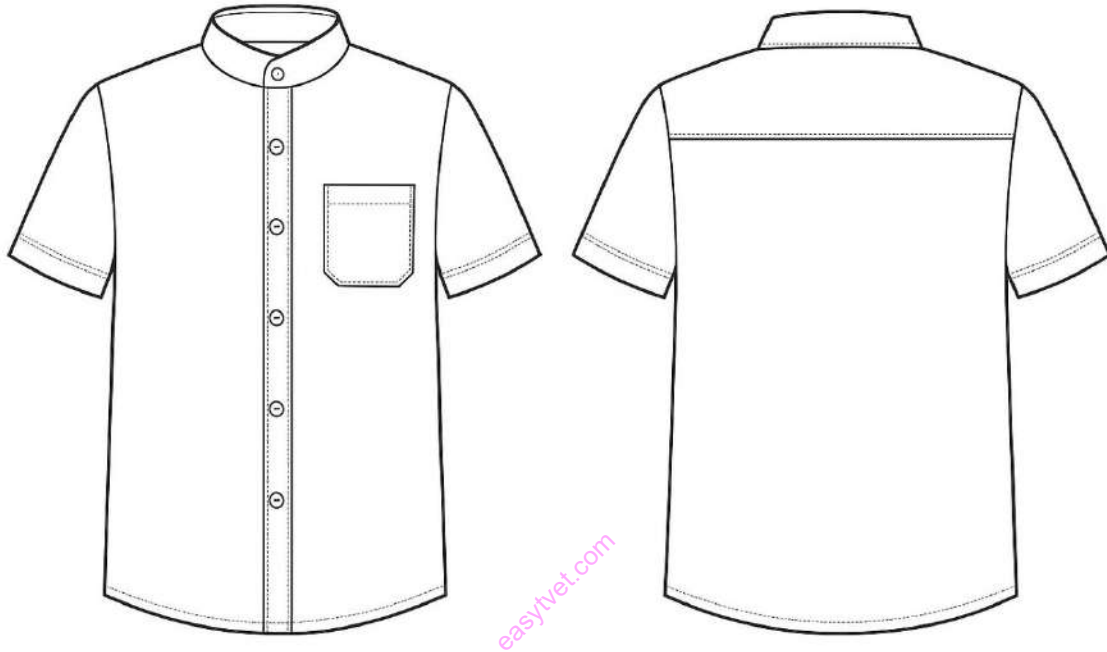

2. PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT SESSION 2: CONSTRUCT A GENTS' SHORT (7 HOURS)

Elements Covered:

3. Lay and cut garment pieces
4. Construct a gents' short

Tasks

- i. Use Personal protective equipment
- ii. Gather required tools, equipment and supplies
- iii. Check functionality of the sewing machine before operating it
- iv. Develop the patterns for the gents short
- v. Using the patterns drafted, lay, cut and transfer pattern marks for the gents' short pieces.

- vi. Stitch the garment pieces as per illustrated garment design and standard operating procedures and note the following;
- Use plain open seams at the side seams.
 - Top stitch the pockets
 - Machine stitch the hem
- vii. Finish and package the trouser in the A4 envelope provided.

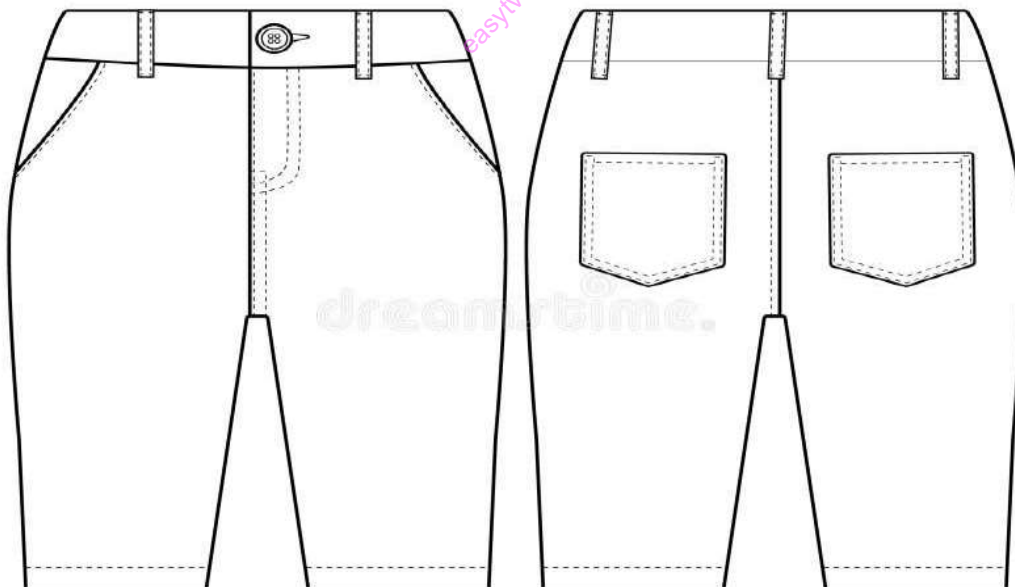

3. PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT SESSION 3: CONSTRUCTION OF A GENTS' SLEEPING TROUSER (7 HOURS)

Elements Covered:

4. Lay and cut garment pieces
5. Construct a gents' trouser

Tasks

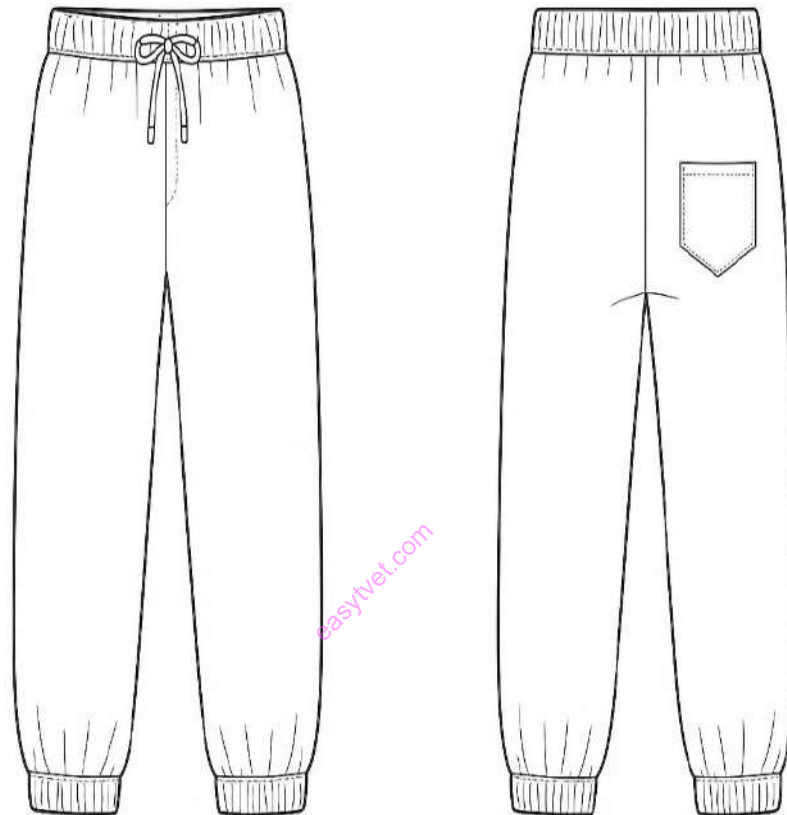
- i. Use Personal protective equipment
- ii. Gather required tools, equipment and supplies
- iii. Check functionality of the sewing machine before operating it
- iv. Develop the patterns for the gents sleeping trouser
- v. Using the patterns drafted, lay, cut and transfer pattern marks for the gents' sleeping trouser pieces.
- vi. Stitch the garment pieces as per illustrated garment design and standard operating procedures and note the following;
 - Use plain closed seams at the side seams.
 - Top stitch the pockets
 - Machine stitch the elasticated hem band
- vii. Finish and package the trouser in the A4 envelope provided.
