- 1) Safari Courier faces reduced demand and wants to explore new business areas. A team has been formed to find opportunities. Identify FOUR ways the team can spot entrepreneurial opportunities. (4 Marks)
- 2) Ken, a young entrepreneur, is developing guidance materials to show his classmates the different entry paths into entrepreneurship. Identify FOUR ways through which Ken can teach them how to become entrepreneurs. (4 Marks)
- 3) A national planning committee is compiling information on how entrepreneurial activities support the country's growth agenda. For inclusion in the report. Identify FOUR contributions of entrepreneurs to national development. (4 Marks)
- 4) A retail chain intends to open operations in a new region and has assigned a technical team to assess the conditions that may affect performance. State FOUR factors the team should consider when evaluating the business environment. (4 Marks)
- 5) Oxyline, a manufacturing enterprise, is preparing a financial strategy to support its planned expansion into new markets. Identify FOUR sources of business finance that the enterprise can consider. (4 Marks)
