PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 1 (3 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Carry Out Site Clearance

Tasks

- i. Mark out an 1500mm x 1500mm square ground surface for clearing using pegs and builder's string.
- ii. Remove vegetation and obstructions.
- iii. Remove topsoil to a depth of 150mm.
- iv. Level the surface.
- v. Dispose the debris.

PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT 2 (3 HOURS)

Elements Covered

1. Carry Out Site Hoarding

Tasks

- i. Mark out a 3500mm length boundary line for hoarding erection.
- ii. Clear and level the boundary line.
- iii. Excavate post holes as per the figure 01 below.
- iv. Erect the posts and braces as per the figure 01 below.
- v. Fix the horizontal rails.
- vi. Fix the G.I sheets hoarding panels as figure 01 below.

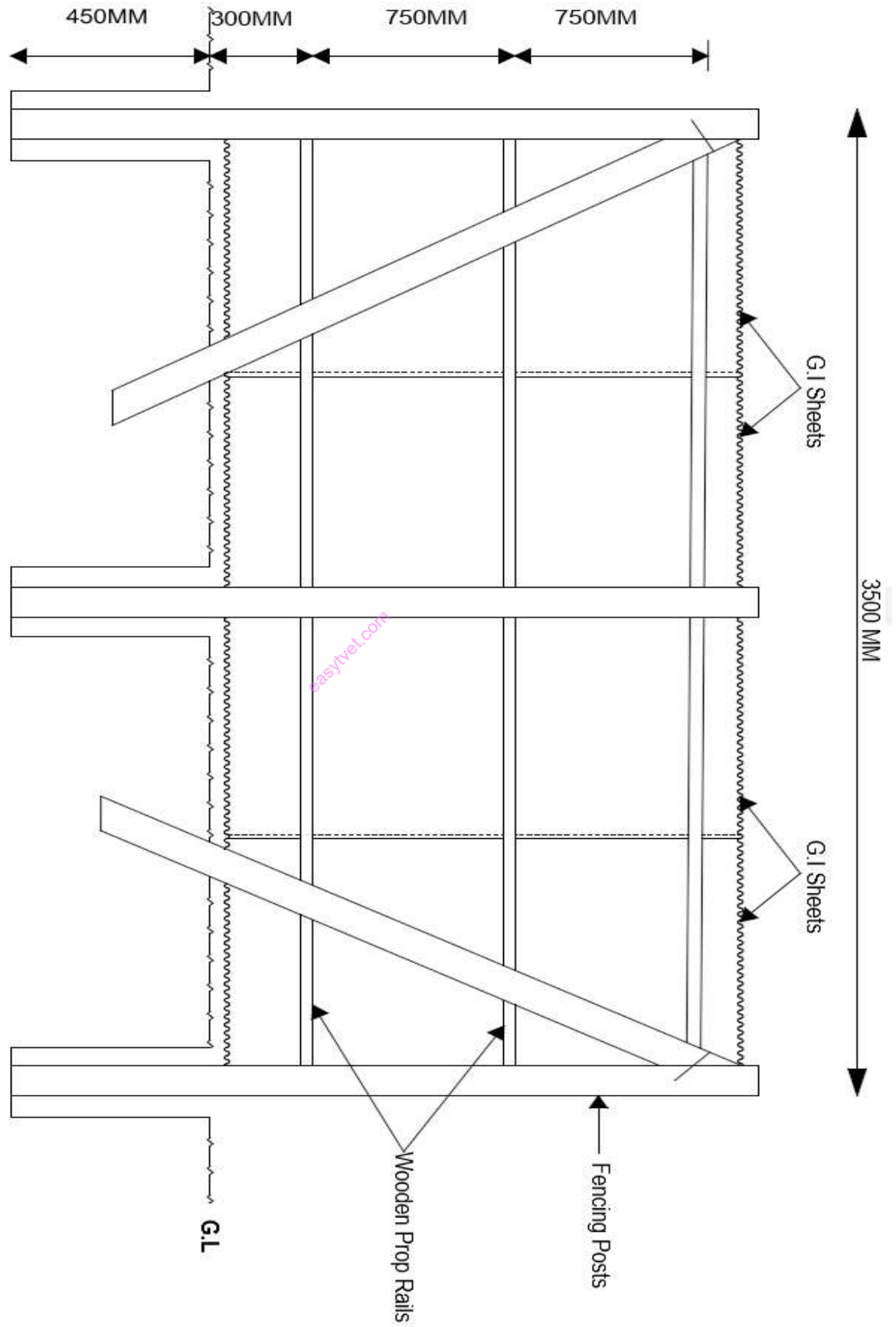

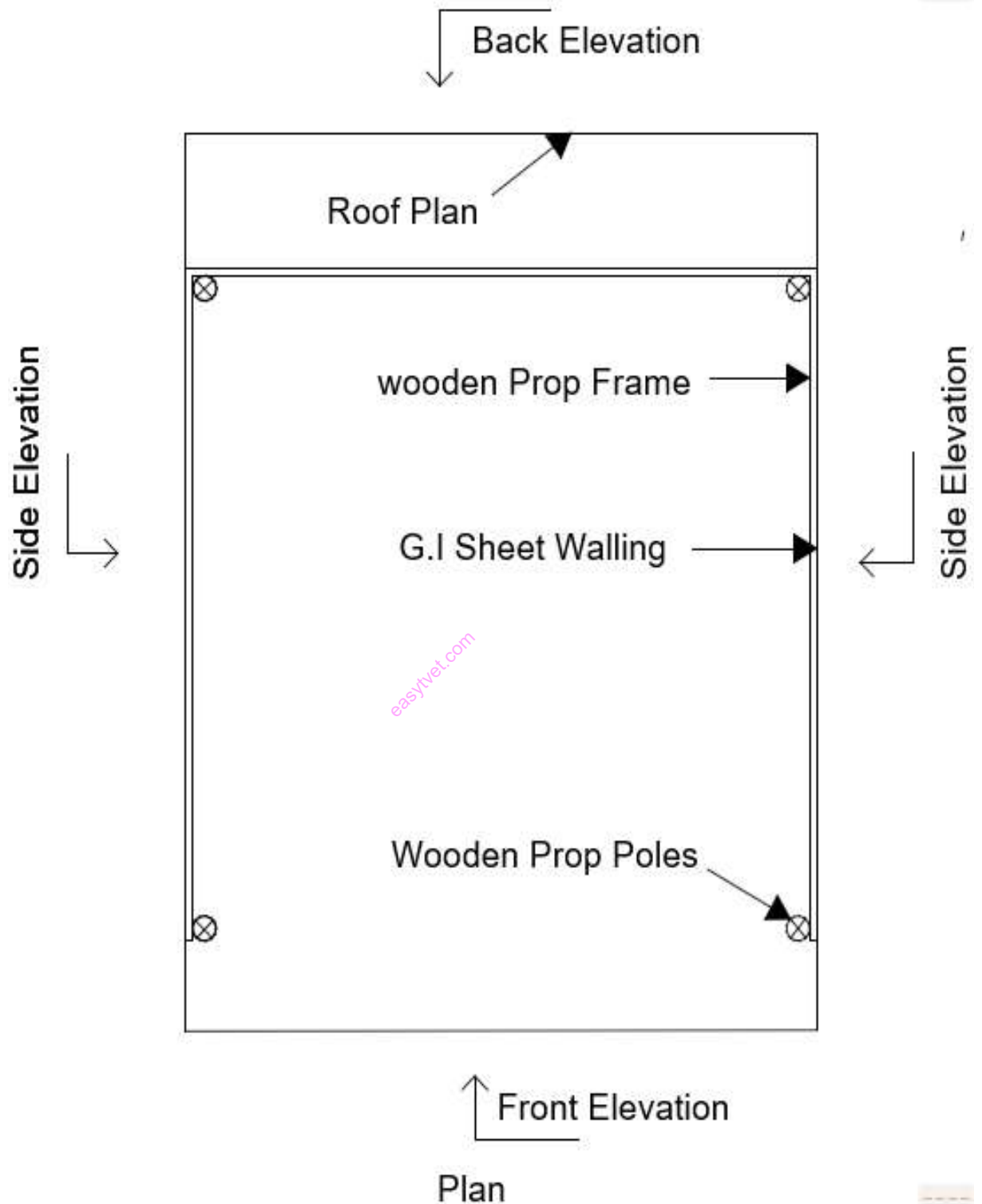

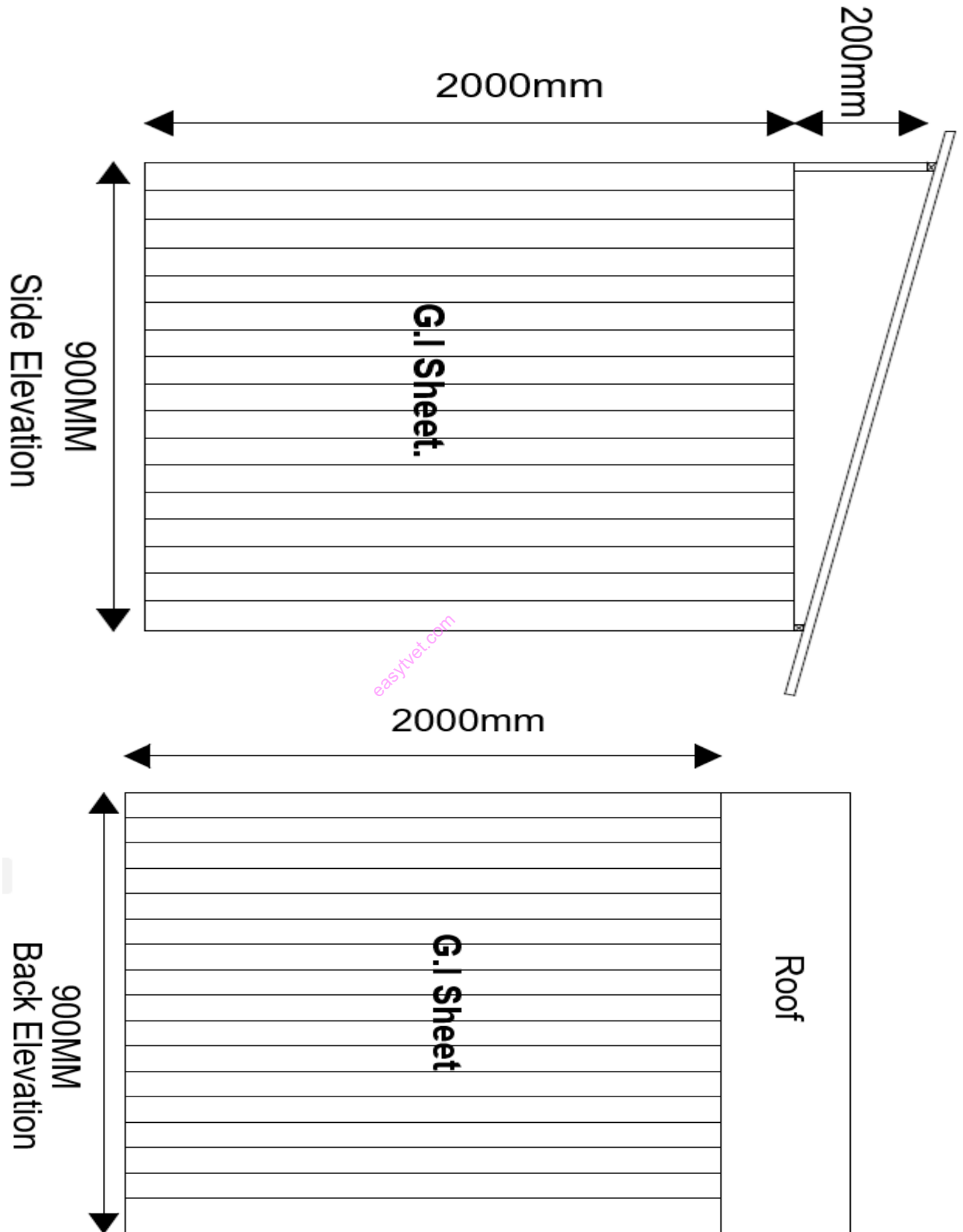
1. Building Construction Site Amenities

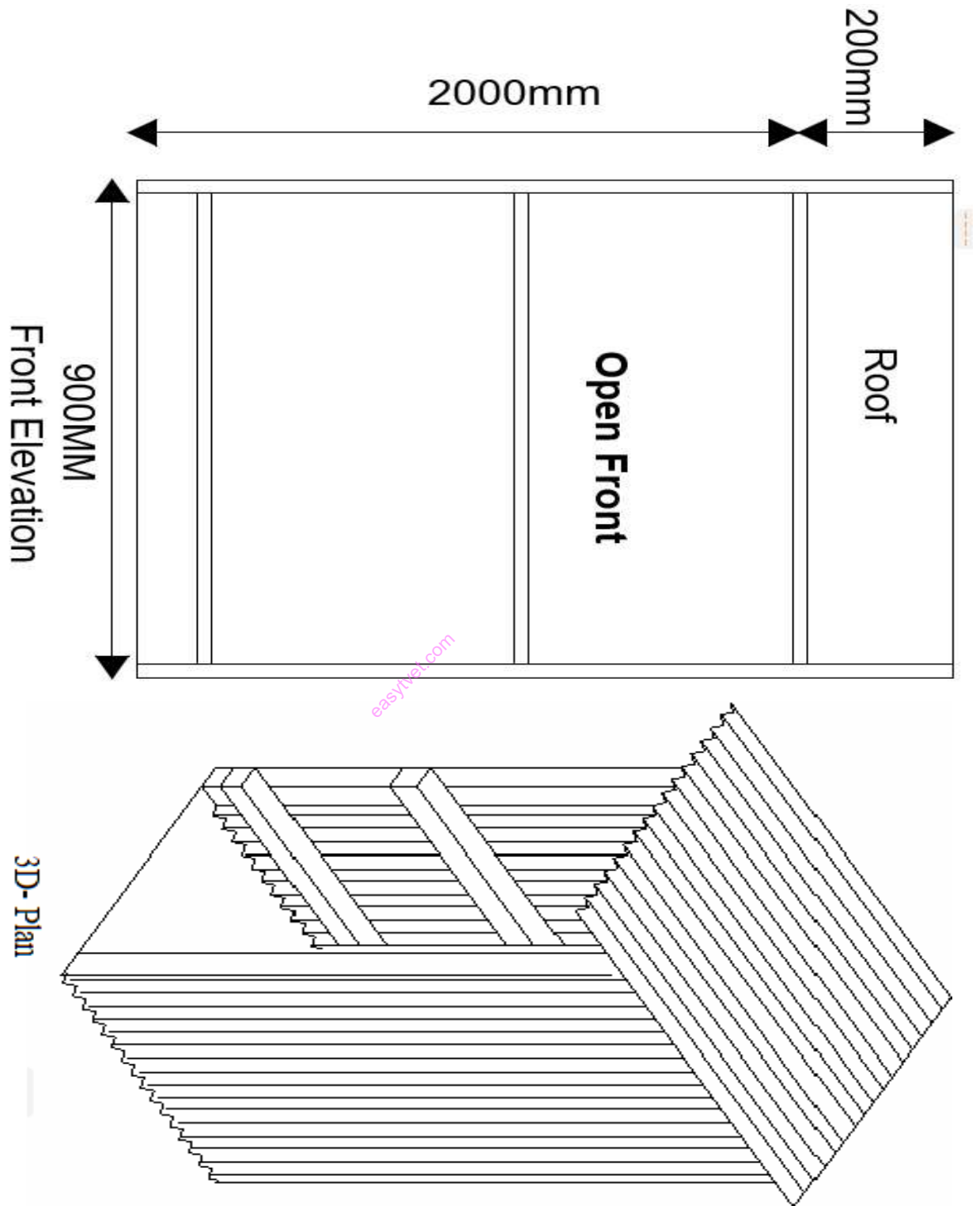
Tasks

- i. Clear and level the construction site.
- ii. Set out the security hut (900 mm x 900mm) as per the working drawings provided.
- iii. Install the vertical posts as per the working drawings provided.
- iv. Fix the horizontal framework as per the working drawings provided.
- v. Fix the G.I sheet walls as per the working drawings provided.
- vi. Install the roof as per the working drawings provided.
